TO: Lockheed Martin Suppliers – ESH Risk Suppliers

SUBJECT: Registration for a New Environment, Safety, and Health (ESH) Compliance Management Program

Lockheed Martin is updating how it will track and manage the compliance of suppliers who could pose an Environment, Safety, and Health (ESH) risk while engaging in activities at Lockheed Martin controlled or owned facilities located in the U.S. ("ESH Risk Suppliers"). ESH risk is defined as any work, activity or service that:

- Presents the risk of loss, ill health, injury, exposure to danger/hazards to any person.
- Could cause harm to a person (people), to property and/or to the environment.
- Requires special licenses/formal training/regulatory certifications to perform activity.
- Introduces a unique/unmanaged ESH risk (regulatory non-compliance, serious injuries, environmental degradation and reputational loss).

Lockheed Martin has accordingly instituted a new ESH Compliance Management Program that is intended to streamline our processes of: (a) qualifying ESH Risk Suppliers for access to U.S. Lockheed Martin facilities, and (b) overseeing, and the periodic review of, suppliers' ongoing compliance while performing projects at Lockheed Martin locations. We will be assisted by our contracted third-party service provider, Avetta, in the operation of this program.

Your company has been identified as potentially holding (or having held) one or more contract(s) requiring it to engage in activities at Lockheed Martin-controlled or owned facilities located in the U.S. that pose an ESH risk. As an ESH risk supplier, you will start to see the requirement of registration under this ESH Compliance Management Program in solicitations and resultant contracts you may receive. To prepare for this, Lockheed Martin is asking that you voluntarily register for the program now and submit the required documentation (e.g., Certificates of Insurance, compliance documents required to be filed with regulators (e.g., U.S. Dept of Labor - OSHA), training certifications, and other similar ESH business data) so that business is not unnecessarily impeded when your company is required to enter a Lockheed Martin controlled or owned facility located in the U.S. to perform work that poses an ESH risk.
